Guest Student Eligibility Criteria

- Good academic standing
- Completed at least 2 semesters of full-time study at the home institution before enrolling at UA
- Meets minimum admission criteria, including English language proficiency (see #3, Proof of Language Proficiency, on this web page for details)
- Willing to live on campus and purchase a campus meal plan

Guest Program Dates

• August 21 through December 15

Nomination Process

- The International Cooperation Department at the home institution must send an email to Robyn Brown, rkb@uakron.edu, listing the student names and attaching a copy of the biographic page of the students' passports
- We encourage home institutions to submit nominations by **April 1**

Application Process

- Students must <u>apply online</u> as a **Special/Non-degree** student and submit official transcript and proof of English proficiency. The application fee will be waived.
- Application deadlines: Fall or Academic Year: May 1 / Spring: November 1

After Acceptance

Accepted students will receive email messages from the International Center indicating next steps, including:

- Submitting financial documents for issuance of a Certificate of Eligibility (needed to apply for a student visa)
- Obtaining a UANet ID (used for student email and logging into campus software)
- Applying for campus housing and a meal plan
- Planning for arrival (airport pickup, orientation, etc.)
- Selecting courses

Estimated Expenses

- **Tuition and fees: \$7,750** (this cost does not reflect partial scholarships that may be arranged through the International Center)
- Room and board: \$6,148 (one semester)
 - Please note this estimate may vary depending on the <u>residence hall</u> and <u>meal plan</u> selected.
 - o Guest students may currently select any residence hall, but this policy is subject to change.
- Mandatory health insurance: \$450 (fall semester)
- **Books: \$500** (one semester)
- Estimated expenses do not include students' personal expenses, travel, etc.
- Exchange students must also pay a <u>SEVIS fee</u> and visa application fee
